

“Asteroids: Coming to Cities Near You”

(“Who Will be Left Behind?” #4)

1. One of the outcomes of the Balls of Fire Natural Disasters will be two end-time movements will be left behind.
2. One of those end-time movements left behind are referred to by Scripture as the “beast”
 - The beast-power will make war against the saints (Rev. 13:7)
 - If you don’t worship the way the beast wants you to worship, you:
 - won’t be able to buy or sell (Rev. 13:17)
 - Will ultimately be facing the death decree (Rev. 13:15-17)
3. The other end-time movement that will be left behind is called the “saints” whose names are written in the Book of Life (Rev. 13:7, 8).
 - They trust in the Everlasting Gospel and are a worldwide missionary movement, sharing the three angel’s message in the context of the everlasting gospel (Rev. 14:6-12)
 - Revelation 14:7 says they will seek to put God first and not the beast; they will not only tell others what Jesus did for them in the past (the Gospel) but will tell others what Jesus is doing now in Heaven, “for the hour of God’s judgment is come”.
 - This other end-time movement will also call the world to worship as well; “worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and fountains of waters” (Rev. 14:7; Ex. 20:11).
4. The Bible clearly describes the natural disaster that will trigger what occurs in Revelation 13 and leaves behind two end-time movements (Rev. 13 & 14). See Luke 17:28-30; 21: 25, 26.
 - NOTE: Both of these end-time movements teach that a natural disaster is coming when the stars will fall again.
5. One of these end-time movements has taught this through Marian Apparitions:
 - These Marian Apparitions began in a Portuguese village of Fatima, between May & October 1917
 - Pope John Paul, a former pope, believed that these Marian Apparitions apply to the time of the end events. They speak of natural disasters as divine judgments from God. They also talk of a transformation of our society and of a coming era of peace.
6. Some of the Marian Apparition predictions:

Sister Agnes from Akita, Japan, of what she said the Virgin Mary told her on October 13, 1973:

“If men do not repent and better themselves, the Father will inflict a terrible punishment on all of humanity. It will be a punishment greater than the Deluge [the Flood of Noah], such as one will never have seen before...Fire will fall from the sky and will wipe out a great part of humanity, the good as well as the bad, sparing neither priests nor faithful. The survivors will find themselves so desolate that they will envy the dead.”

“The Thunder of Justice” by Ted and Maureen Flynn, 1993:

“An unforeseen fire will descend over the whole earth, and a great part of humanity will be destroyed”

“The earth will go out of its orbit for three days. At that time the Second Coming of Christ will be near. The devil will take over the world”

“Fire will descend from Heaven and this will be a sign that the Justice of God has now fixed the hour of His great manifestation”

“Saint Peter & Saint Paul, having come down from heaven, shall preach in the whole world and designate a new Pope. A great light will flash from their bodies and will settle upon the cardinal who is to become Pope. Christianity, then, will spread throughout the world (TJ, 353).

“In those days there will be one Shepherd and one Faith, that of the Roman Catholic Church (TJ, 354)

“The Queen of Peace”—named after the Virgin Mary:

“Through a series of human, natural and supernatural events, the long-awaited “Era of Peace”, predicted at Fatima in 1917, is said to be about to occur. ...mankind will witness the transformation of the world in an incredible fashion... The Virgin’s words indicate the face of the earth will be transformed... Peace will rule and the church will reign. Repeatedly, Mary has told visionaries that God is going to give signs to return to Him, great miracles and perhaps the sight of Christ himself.... “Other miracles will be of such grand design that it is said only obstinate sinners will be able to deny them. Marian followers say these miracles will be worldwide and given so ‘that all may believe’.” “After the miracles, the visionaries say, the world will be cleansed of all who choose to remain attached to evil and sin”.

“Then Jesus Christ, in an act of His justice and His great mercy, will command His angels to have all His enemies put to death. Suddenly, the persecutors of the Church of Jesus Christ and all those given over to sin will perish and the earth will become desert-like. And then peace will be made, and man will be reconciled with God. Jesus Christ will be served, worshiped, and glorified. Charity will flourish everywhere. (TJ, 114)

7. Just as Noah believed that God would send the Flood we can expect similar experiences:

-#1 Noah had never been in a world-wide flood before, and we have never had these heavenly bodies fall on cities any place in this world.

#2 Noah was called to wait in faith for God’s promise of a world-wide flood to come. We too have to wait in faith for God’s predictions that cities will be destroyed by these heavenly bodies.

#3 Noah and his family waited in active faith; they built an Ark and spread the word that God would send a flood, come into the Ark of safety. We too must wait in faith and show that we believe what the Bible teaches about Christ and the future. What would that look like? This is the time to:

-draw near in a relationship with Christ.

-share with others the Good News about Jesus Christ.

-study the prophecies of the Bible for ourselves.

-warn others about the coming judgments of God.

-seriously pray whether it is safe to live in the wickedness of our cities and to relocate to country property.

#4 Noah’s message was not very popular; people made fun of it and of him. Do not be surprised that we too will experience the same. What God asks of us is to be faithful in sharing His Gospel message and the prophecies of the Bible, just as Noah was faithful.

8. What I have shared with you these 4 evenings is either Biblical and true, OR it is a twisting of Scriptures—a religious hoax. Either God is calling you to take a decided action about this Bible truth OR He would have you do nothing. Either God has been calling you to dedicate your life to Christ and to understand and apply the Bible prophecies to your life now and the future; OR He wants you to treat Bible Prophecy as some mystery and not worth your time.

WE HAVE NOTHING TO FEAR FOR THE FUTURE, UNLESS WE FORGET WHAT CHRIST HAS DONE FOR US IN THE PAST, AND NEGLECT TO HEED HIS PROPHECIES.
