

LEST WE FORGET OCTOBER 22, 1844

- WHAT?** Come and meet together and sing some of the very songs the Millerite Believers sang prior to the 1844 Disappointment, called "Millerite Hymns and Tunes."
- WHEN?** Sabbath, October 14 Church Service Time
- WHERE?** **Here at Canyonville Adventist Church**
- WHY?** For the Millerite Adventist believers, October 22, 1844 was "The Great Disappointment". Jesus did not come, but we know what really happened and why. This Bible discovery has given us our mission as Seventh-day Adventist Christians: to tell the world what the Christ of the Cross is doing now. This too is our message.
