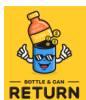

Progress Report on Search for Daniel Lui & Janelle Alder

Thank you to each of you for your interest and support of the T-shirt Campaign and further searching into the disappearance of Daniel and Janelle. This is an update of what has happened to date. Please note that we are still actively following up on some of the tips received. We are wanting to provide as much information as possible to everyone involved, but are unable to yet share some specific details of the search.

We were able to initially form two volunteer teams, searching and distributing 1,000 T-shirts in both the Philippines and Malaysia. They talked with officials, locals, and searched the island coasts for wreckage—Nothing Found. Tips came in during initial conversations, as well as by anonymous phone calls. Following up on these tips, as several of them independently reinforce and corroborate each other.

We feel it is important to stay in-country in order to explore leads as they present themselves until they are either confirmed or shown to be a dead-end or unrelated. We have maintained at least one volunteer team present on the ground since the first of August. We are currently working on an active lead, and hope to continue extending this work until this lead ends. We are looking for wreckage and talking to people who would offer us information in order to find something that would help us push for a formal investigation. More detailed information can be shared once this phase is no longer active, but at this point we are keeping specific information highly compartmentalized in order to minimize any chance of compromising the search.

This project has extended far beyond the initial envisioned 2 week field time, and is currently beyond 2 months of continuous field work. You have helped raise \$38,800. We are incredibly grateful for your support. We are also very grateful for the amazing donations of time and the personal sacrifice of our volunteers. They are volunteering their time, using personal equipment and setting aside their other work to help with this project. This is an incredible sacrifice. They are donating their time, and we are paying expenses. Expenses have far exceeded the funds raised. So far, we have spent around \$86,000, and it is now costing around \$5,000 per week to remain functional in the field. Any additional help with expenses is greatly appreciated.
