The Spirit of Prophecy, a spiritual gift, is an identifying mark of the remnant church. (Revelation 14:12; 19:10)

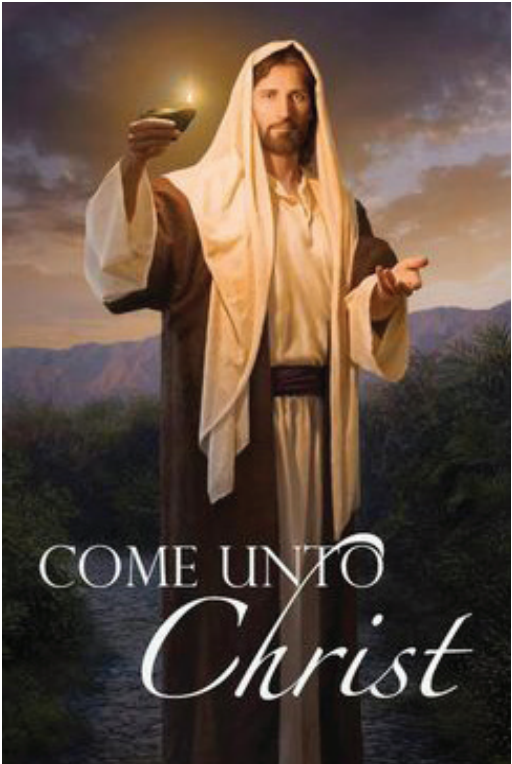
Tithes and offerings support church organization. (Malachi 3:8-10)
